

Created in 1981 in Berlin by Wau Holland

Annual conferences since 1984

Official non-benefit association since 1986

First CCCamp in 1999

Actual influence on German politics

1500 official members (and all the others...)

Revendications

The information must be free (as of freedom)

The information must be free of charge

Computers must be accessible and improve life

Privacy must be respected

Preference for decentralization (as a protection against concentrated power)

Consider people from their actions, not their look


